Spanish National Research Council, CSIC

Spanish Cultural Heritage Institute (IPCE-MECD)

Research, conservation and restoration of Spanish Cultural Heritage. Belongs to the Spanish Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports.



Centro Nacional de Investigación sobre la Evolución Humana, CENIEH

Belongs to the national network of Unique Scientific & Technical Infrastructures.

Research on human evolution (archaeological and paleontological collections).

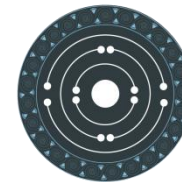

- National Node initially includes CSIC, IPCE-MECD and CENIEH.
Coordination of Spanish node of E-RIHS by CSIC
- Memorandum of Understanding being prepared by the three institutions
- TechnoHeritage National Network, from 2011. Recent support from MINECO "Redes de Excelencia". Call 2016, HAR2016-81748-REDT

Timeline

- ESFRI Roadmap entry: 2016
- Preparation phase: 2017-2019
- Construction phase: 2020-2021
- Operation start: 2022

Preparatory phase of E-RIHS Spain

- Starting Feb 2017
- Technoheritage Network as base for creating the E-RIHS Spanish Node
- Composition to be defined in PP
- Participation criteria according to guidelines to be established at European level during E-RIHS PP
- Based in excellence, uniqueness, background, access capabilities/experience, to users in **Cultural and Natural Heritage**
- Other National Nodes in more advanced stages of development
